

## Extended - Services work on the footpath at the corner of George and Margaret Streets

**Continuous day and night works extended: Services installation works requiring a partial lane and footpath closure will continue along the footpath of George Street and a small section of Margaret Street, outside The Mansions (heritage building) from 6.30pm Saturday 5 August to 6.30pm Saturday 26 August.**

### When:

On 18 July, a notice was issued for continuous day and night work along George St from 25 July to 5 August. This work has now been extended **from 6.30pm Saturday 6 August until 6.30pm Saturday 26 August 2017** to install electrical services and pour a concrete pit.

### Where:

The work will take place in the footpath on the southern side of George Street near the intersection of Margaret Street (outside the Mansions) and for a short 2 metre distance along Margaret Street.

The Margaret Street footpath will remain open at all times during the day Monday to Friday to allow for 1WS pedestrian traffic.

### What to expect:

Equipment used will include an excavator, piling rig, and small tipper trucks, hand tools, formwork building materials and small trucks for deliveries.

The work is necessary to install important services as part of the demolition and enabling works for the Queen's Wharf Brisbane project.

## Queen's Wharf Brisbane

Queen's Wharf Brisbane will be a transformational city changing project for Brisbane that will see an underutilised area of the CBD brought back to life with new purpose and exciting energy.

When complete there will be 50 restaurants, cafes and bars; a signature sky deck approximately 100 metres above William St and open to the public, five and six-star luxury hotels, the equivalent of 12 football fields of public space, world-class gaming, a new pedestrian bridge, four key retail zones and 2,000 residential apartments.

The core of the development is expected to open in 2022 with the transformation of Treasury Hotel and Casino into a high end retail centre and The Ritz-Carlton Brisbane to be complete in 2024.


## Pedestrian access:

Pedestrian access will be available at all times. To ensure the safety of pedestrians and motorists, traffic controllers will be on hand to provide assistance as required.

The section of footpath on Margaret Street leading to/from 1 William Street will remain open to pedestrians from 7am to 7pm Monday to Friday. Night time closures of part of the Margaret Street footpath may be required, however access will be maintained in a reduced capacity.

## Vehicle lane closures:

To maintain safety, exclusion zones will be set-up around the work zone at all times during the services installation. This will include the need for a single lane closure in the eastbound traffic lane on George Street. Traffic controllers will be in place to assist with traffic movements.
