

Temporary Margaret St off-ramp closure for southbound traffic

On Saturday 17 September 2022, out-of-hours works and a temporary traffic detour will be required for works adjacent to the Margaret St off-ramp.

When

Out-of-hours works are scheduled on **Saturday 17 September 2022 from 3am and 11am** requiring an exclusion area on Margaret St while works occur within the Queen's Wharf site. Early morning road closures are required to minimise impacts to the road network over the weekend. All works are subject to weather and site conditions.

Where

Work will occur within the Queen's Wharf site while the Margaret St off-ramp is temporarily closed as an exclusion zone (see map). A temporary lane closure and reduced speed limits will be in place for southbound traffic.

Temporary diversion

For inbound city traffic, use Elizabeth St or Turbot St Riverside Expressway off-ramps. Access to 1 William Street will be via Alice St and Gardens Point Road. Access to 1 William Street will be maintained at all times.

Queen's Wharf Brisbane

Queen's Wharf Brisbane is a transformational city changing development for Brisbane. It is bringing an underutilised area of the CBD back to life with new purpose and exciting energy.

When complete there will be a new pedestrian bridge from the integrated resort development, direct to the South Bank Cultural Forecourt.

Queen's Wharf Brisbane will include more than 50 restaurants, bars, and cafes; a signature Sky Deck approximately 100 metres above William St; luxury five- and six-star hotels; the equivalent of 12 football fields of public space, a new casino to replace the existing casino; multiple retail zones and up to 1,500 residential apartments.

The integrated resort will commence a staged opening from the second half of 2023.



Out-of-hours works will include the following:

- A temporary Margaret St off-ramp closure for southbound traffic on the Riverside Expressway
- Temporary lane closures for southbound traffic on the Riverside Expressway
- Reduced speed limits on the Riverside Expressway on the approach to the construction site
- Noisy works including, rattle guns and hammering on steel
- Workers entering and exiting the site between approved hours.
