

George Street footpath upgrades between Charlotte and Mary Street

From 13 June 2023 works to upgrade a section of the George St footpath will commence. Footpath to remain open to Pedestrians.

When:

From **Tuesday 13 June 2023** works on the north side footpath between Mary and Charlotte Streets (opposite the integrated resort development) will take place. Work hours will be between 6am and 4pm Monday to Friday for approximately 6 weeks.

Where:

Footpath works will be taking place on George Street (north side) between Mary and Charlotte Streets. There will be temporary fencing in place around the work area for the safety of pedestrians and workers.

Access for pedestrians on George Street will remain open.

Changed parking conditions on George Street:

Street car parking between Charlotte and Mary Streets will be temporarily removed to accommodate an exclusion zone for plant/equipment and for a work area while the footpath upgrades are underway.

Queen's Wharf Brisbane

Queen's Wharf Brisbane is a transformational city changing development for Brisbane. It is bringing an underutilised area of the CBD back to life with new purpose and exciting energy.

When complete there will be a new pedestrian bridge from the integrated resort development, direct to the South Bank Cultural Forecourt.

Queen's Wharf Brisbane will include more than 50 restaurants, bars, and cafes; a signature Sky Deck approximately 100 metres above William St; luxury five- and six-star hotels; the equivalent of 12 football fields of public space, a new casino to replace the existing casino; multiple retail zones and up to 2,000 residential apartments.

The integrated resort will commence a staged opening from April 2024.



- Workers behind the temporary fencing during construction hours.
- Temporarily reduced footpath width.
